Types of Bequests

There are several ways to include a bequest in your will or revocable living trust. Here are some examples to consider with your family and share with your attorney or professional advisor.

1. Specific Bequest

"I give, devise and bequeath the sum of \$ xxx to Cedarcrest, Inc., a non-profit corporation with its principal place of business located in Keene, New Hampshire, for its general purposes."

2. Bequest of a percent of your estate or Residuary Bequest

"I give devise and bequeath xx% of all the rest, residue and remainder of my property owned at my death, whether real or personal, and wherever located to Cedarcrest, Inc., a non-profit corporation with its principal place of business located in Keene, New Hampshire, for its general purposes."

3. Contingent Bequest

"If my brother John Doe fails to survive me, I give, devise and bequeath his share of my estate to Cedarcrest, Inc., a non-profit corporation with its principal place of business located in Keene, New Hampshire, for its general corporate purposes."

A **Codicil** or amendment may also be made to your existing will or revocable living trust. A bequest to Cedarcrest may offer estate tax savings as well. Please contact us for additional information.
